Trap Shooting Rules

Open to Members and their guests. Dates will be posted and may be amended by the Board.

General Rules

1. All shooters must follow and obey all Federal, State, and Club rules and guidelines.
 2. No one under 16 years of age will be allowed in the shooting area unless accompanied by a responsible adult. FOID cards are required of all adults.
 3. No alcoholic beverages are allowed before or during shooting. Board Members reserve the right to deny participation if alcohol consumption is suspected.
 4. Members may freely throw their own clay targets in the Trap Field after Labor Day weekend until the Saturday before Memorial Day, between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., but NOT during waterfowl hunting season. Members throwing their own clay targets may not use the Club thrower/trap house.
 5. Eye and ear protection is recommended. The Club will provide ear plugs upon request.
 6. No more than one shooter per station at a time; wait for the "pull" signal from the previous shooter to clear.
 7. Muzzles must be pointed downrange at all times; no exceptions for casual handling.
 8. Shooters are responsible for policing their own spent hulls and any broken target debris.
 9. Trap house / thrower may only be operated by a designated puller or authorized Member.
 10. Guests must be accompanied by a Member at all times while on the range.
 11. Participation is at the shooter's own risk; the Club assumes no liability for injury.
 12. For scheduled Club trap shooting events, if no one participates within the first hour of the event, it will be cancelled.
 13. Any Member or guest that is not compliant with these rules may be asked to leave the shoot and potentially lose trap shooting privileges upon Board review.
